**Response to the COVID-19 Pandemic:**

- Morning drop off in the front foyer, with one family in the foyer at a time. Each child will have their temperature recorded and be observed for any obvious symptoms of illness. Parents please wear a mask at drop off time.
- Anyone with a temperature of 100.4 or greater, or with multiple symptoms will NOT be admitted into the building and cannot return to the school for 48 hours, symptom free without medication.
- We ask that you call 5 minutes before picking up and we will bring your child/ren to your car. The runners or teachers will bring your child to your car, we ask that parents wear masks at this time also.
- All children over the age of two are required to wear masks at drop off, pick up and in the hallways, if you would like to send a mask in with your child you may do so. It must be labeled with first and last name, and we ask that you provide a Ziplock bag for your child to put their mask in (also labeled) when they want to take it off.
- We ask that EVERY child please bring in a pair of clean shoes to wear in the classroom. These shoes will be labeled and kept in your child's cubby in a Ziplock bag. Your child will use these shoes for inside the classroom and will be changed back into the normal daily shoes when they go to the playgrounds or when they return home for the day.
- We will still maintain our social distancing efforts in the classroom, limiting the number of children at a center, seating arrangements, and no family style meals.
- We have been utilizing our hospital grade electrostatic sprayer for the past year and a half in all our classrooms on a weekly basis. Increasing our deep-cleans on an as needed basis especially during cold and flu season.
- Since COVID-19 has been present we have increased our usage to daily in each classroom. We are cleaning each individual toy in the classrooms as well. We have also used our bleach and water spray to clean each individual center prior to the next child using it. As well as to disinfect our playground equipment in between each class.

We have a procedural COVID-19 packet that we go over and hand to all parents before registering. These need to be read and signed before admittance. Here are a few procedures we do follow:

- We have a 1:10 ratio with one teacher and no one else in or out of the classroom.
- The classroom and materials are sanitized every night.
- No one in the building except for teachers and students.
- Check and fill out a questionnaire before allowing children into building.

**Response to the COVID-19 Pandemic:**

Your child's safety and health is of the utmost concern at MCP. We are following the Department of Children and Family Services, the CDC and the Lake County Department of Public Health guidelines for COVID-19 mitigations.

- Children are screened at the door, with a temperature and wellness check, parents are currently not allowed in the preschool.
- Children and staff wear masks and are encouraged to wash hands frequently. (After toileting, touching mouth or nose, before and after eating and at predetermined times throughout the session) Hand sanitizer is available for use.
- Toys and surfaces are disinfected as needed and all items used are cleaned and disinfected between sessions.
- Snacks are served to each child by a gloved adult.
- Children and staff are not allowed to attend if they are feeling unwell or have any symptoms of respiratory illness.
- We are limited to 15 children in our MWF classes, and remain below state standards for ratios in all classes. Small class size helps to reduce potential spread of any disease.
